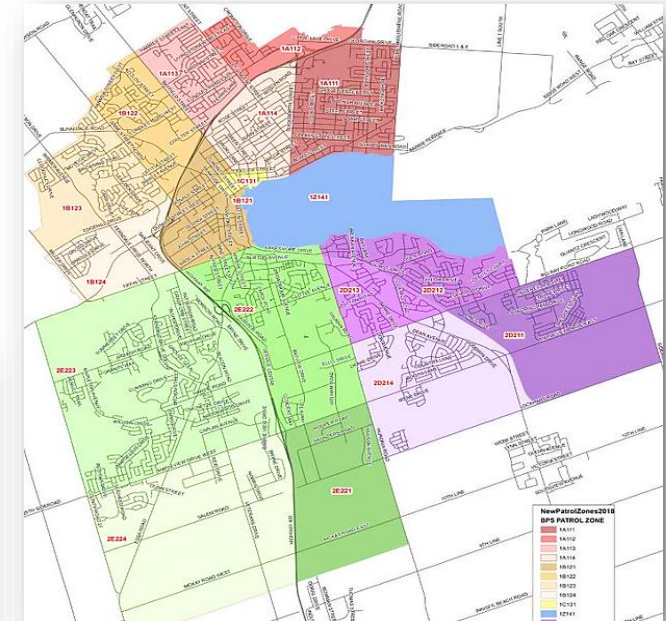


Police Initiatives – Harm Spot's


Harm Spots

7 Harm Spot Locations are currently patrolled throughout the city of Barrie, averaging 155 checks per month by front-line officers (approx. 50 hours)

Averaging a 60% decrease in crime harm within identified locations from the pre-measures of the initiative.




Police Initiatives – Traffic Hot Spot's



TRAFFIC HOTSPOT PROJECT

As part of our commitment to traffic safety, we are looking at what tactics police can use to reduce the number of MVCs occurring at identified high-volume hotspots. The Traffic Hotspot Project will explore different traffic calming and enforcement strategies as well as implement an educational campaign to reduce collisions.

NEXT STEPS

- **Public Education:** A public awareness campaign will be launched to inform the public of the project and affected intersections.
- **Target, Test & Track:** Each intersection will be targeted with a different traffic calming or enforcement strategy.
- **Inform future deployment strategies:** Results will be reviewed and presented so that the findings can help inform future deployment strategies and contribute to safer streets and pathways.

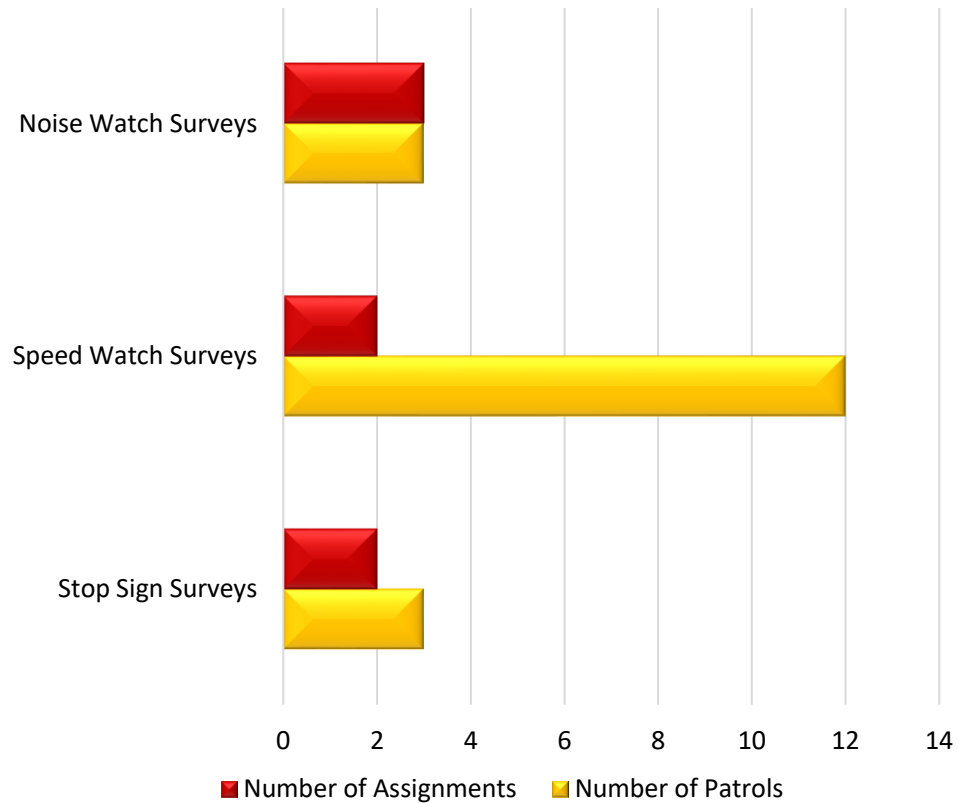
